IV. Report from the Americas Regional Chairman

Chairman David Goldner (Baltimore) reviewed the slate of nominations for the 2016/2017 fiscal year as follows:

Worldwide Chairman Howard Rosen (Phoenix) discussed the recent activities of the Worldwide Board, including the successful recruiting campaign forged in India, where the membership increased from 3-9 firms in the past two years. He also advised that at its upcoming meeting on Wednesday, the board will discuss the specific amount of block grants that will be given to each region, which will be based on the percentage of total dues paid by that region. He concluded by inviting everyone to attend the 2016 Worldwide Meeting to be held in Santiago, Chile, on November 12-15.
